At Fairfield Infant and Nursery, we celebrate the individuality of all pupils, and we support children to enjoy their time at school and be successful.

We work with other professionals, parents and the children themselves to find out what they need and how best to support them.

When children need extra help to access the curriculum, we ensure that we give them the best support we can. We have a dedicated team of teachers and support staff working towards this aim. Children's needs are catered for within their own class and, where useful, may be withdrawn for short periods to work with a specialist adult, individually or in a small group. Similarly, children who are identified as gifted or talented, demonstrating a particular aptitude in a curriculum area, will be given the opportunity to extend their learning in class, and may have the opportunity to work on challenges outside the classroom.

We know that children do best when we work closely with families, so parents/guardians are always welcome to see us to discuss their child's progress.
