What does a Family Support Worker do?

- Provide a listening ear and support to families.
- Work as a link between home and school, keeping lines of communication open between parents and school staff.
- Provide opportunities for parents to meet with other parents through drop in sessions and groups.
- Work with children in the school who need extra support.
- Signpost parents and families to services within the area, depending on their need.
- Help families by assisting them with the Early Help process.
- Work with other professionals to help families achieve their goals.
